Mitigation: Yellow River Ranch Mitigation Area (UWRMP 5.2.4)

Mitigation for wetland impacts associated with replacement of the US 90 Yellow River Bridge will be accomplished via debiting credits from the Yellow River Ranch Mitigation Area (UWRMP 5.2.4) credit ledger. The exact number of credits to be debited will be dictated by state and federal permit conditions. Debiting of credits will occur upon receipt of FDOT funds and issuance of state and federal permits.

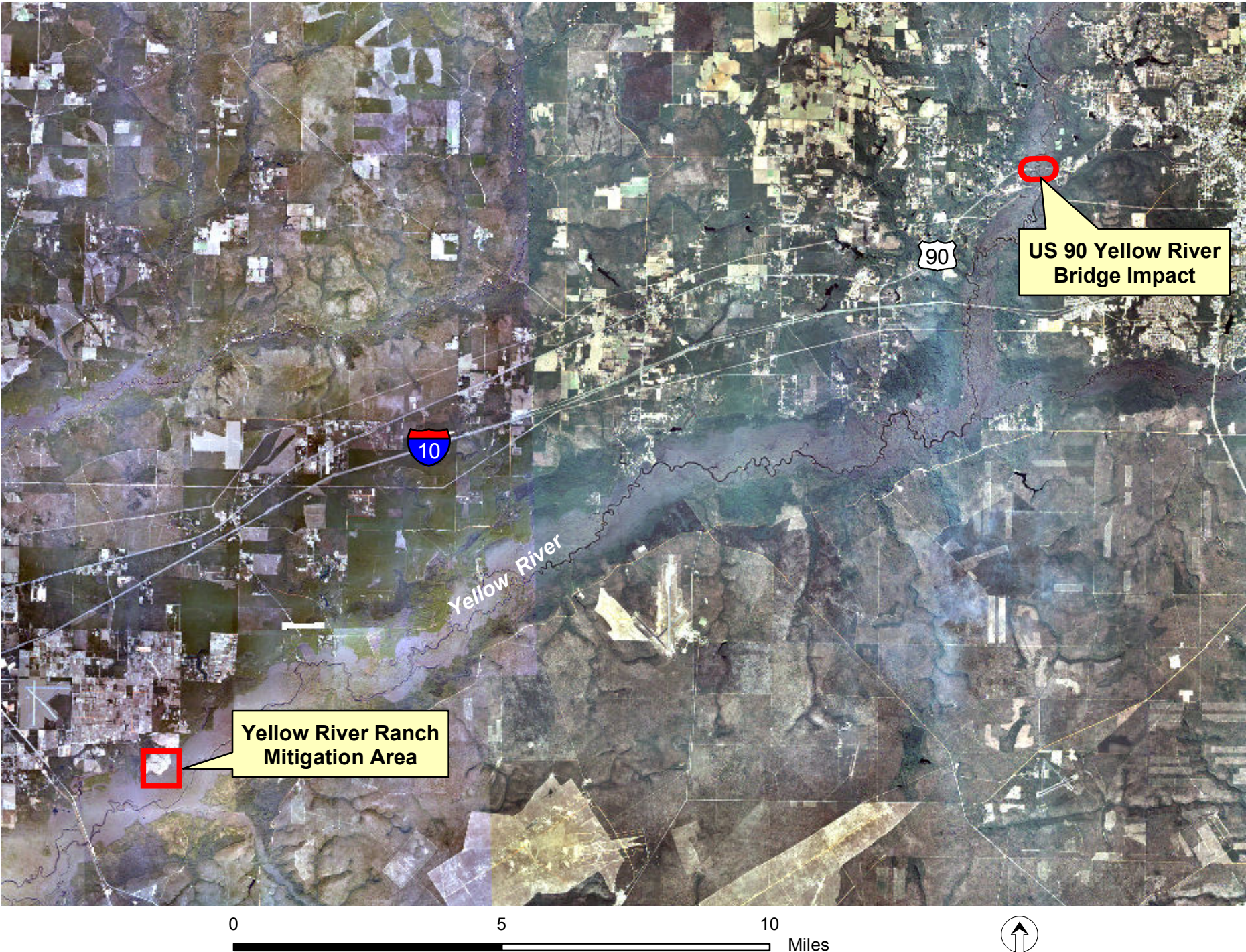
This mitigation appropriately offsets the impacts because the impacts and mitigation are (1) within the same watershed (i.e., the Yellow River watershed), and (2) are similar forested palustrine wetlands.

Ample mitigation credits (>12 UMAM credits) are currently available at the Yellow River Ranch Mitigation Area to offset this impact. As such, there will be no delay between initiation of work and implementation of mitigation.

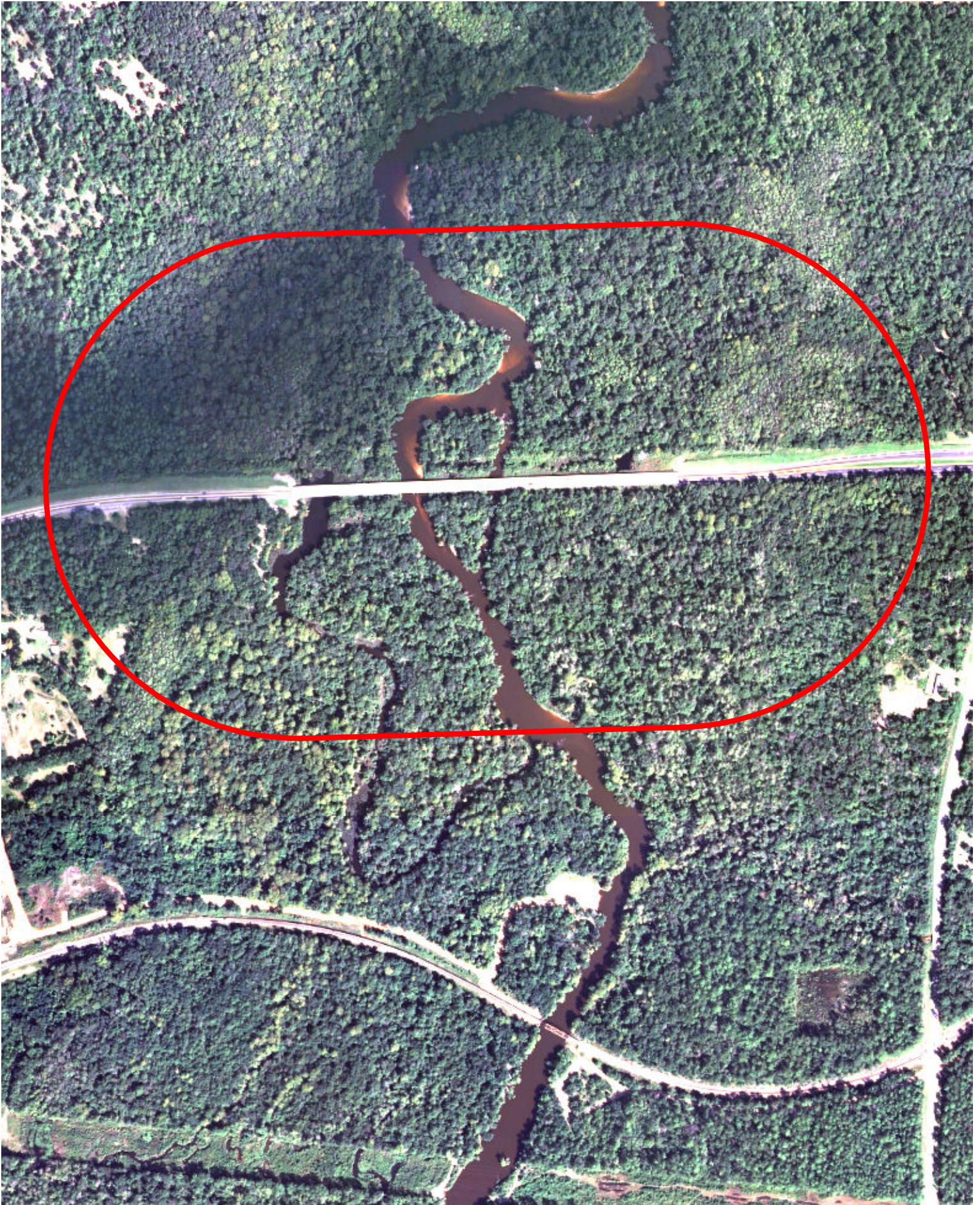
It is the consensus of the Umbrella Plan Review Team (see March, 2011 meeting minutes) that this mitigation will appropriately offset the impacts.
