The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request received December 7, 2009. The project known as the State Road 77 road-widening project is located along 2.7 miles of State Road 77, from the north end of the Bailey Bride at North Bay northward to the intersection of SR 77 with County Road 2300, in Sections 21, 26, 27, 33 and 34, Township 2 South, Range 14 West, Bay County, Florida.

The proposed modification is to change the mitigation condition from the purchase of 14.69 federal credits from the Sand Hill Lakes Mitigation Bank to: The permittee shall provide verification that 11.13 credits would remain debited from the Sand Hill Mitigation Bank and 3.56 credits would be debited from the Ward Creek West credit ledger.

The impact of your proposal on navigation and the environment have been reviewed and found to be insignificant. The permit is hereby modified in accordance with your request. You should attach this letter to the permit. All other conditions of the permit remain in full force and effect.
