The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request received December 7, 2009. The project known as the State Road 79 road-widening project, is located along 10.3 miles of State Road 79 from U.S. Highway 98, north to the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW), in Section 7, Township 3 South, Range 16 West, Bay County, Florida.

The proposed modification is to change the mitigation condition from the purchase of 23.11 federal credits from the Sand Hill Lakes Mitigation Bank to: The permittee shall provide verification that 14.09 credits would be remain debited from the Sand Hill Mitigation Bank and 9.02 credits would be debited from the Ward Creek West credit ledger.


