

# Pitt and Sylvan Springs - Econfina Creek WMA



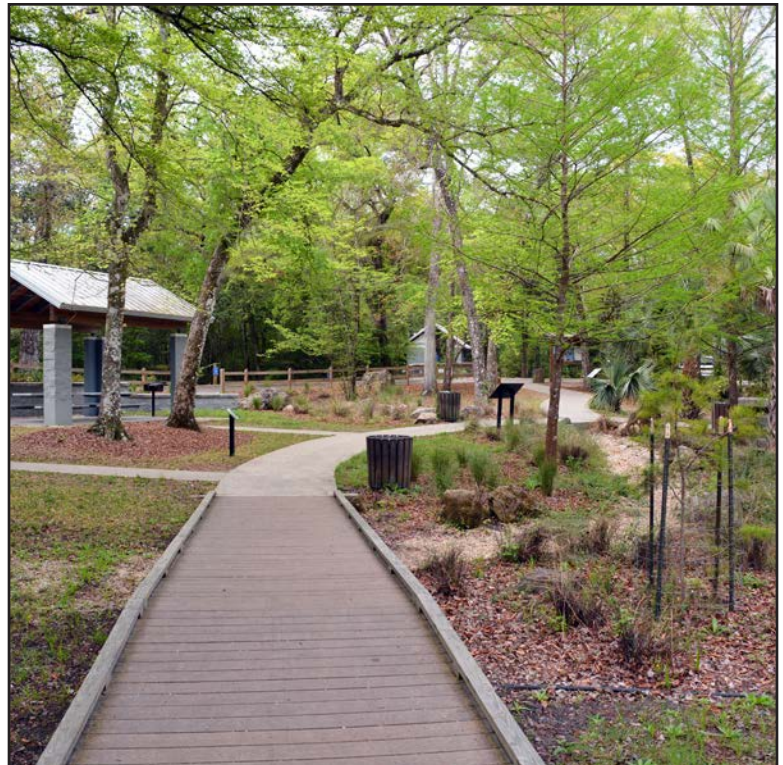
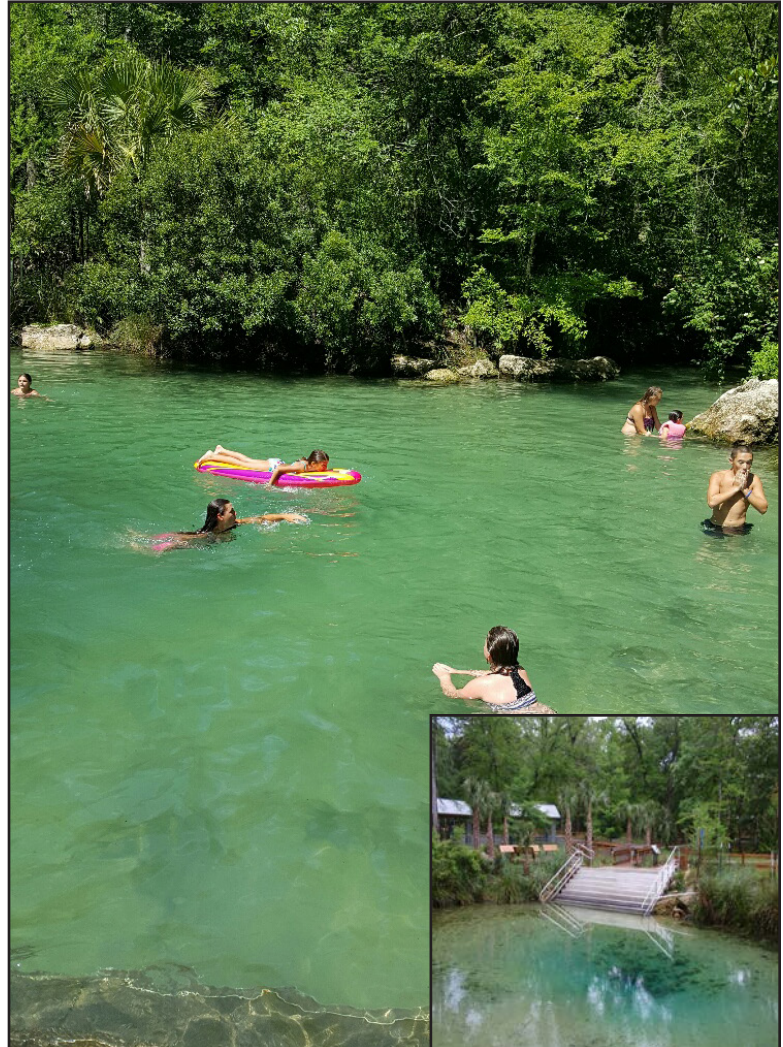

**Pitt and Sylvan Springs** is a popular recreation site that offers swimming, picnic pavilions that are first-come, first-serve, composting restrooms, an extensive trail and boardwalk system connecting to the revamped canoe dock on the Econfina Creek and Williford Spring. It has a tube launch dock at the Sylvan Spring-run and overlook decks at Pitt and Sylvan Springs. This is a day use only site that is open from sunrise to sunset. Alcohol prohibited.

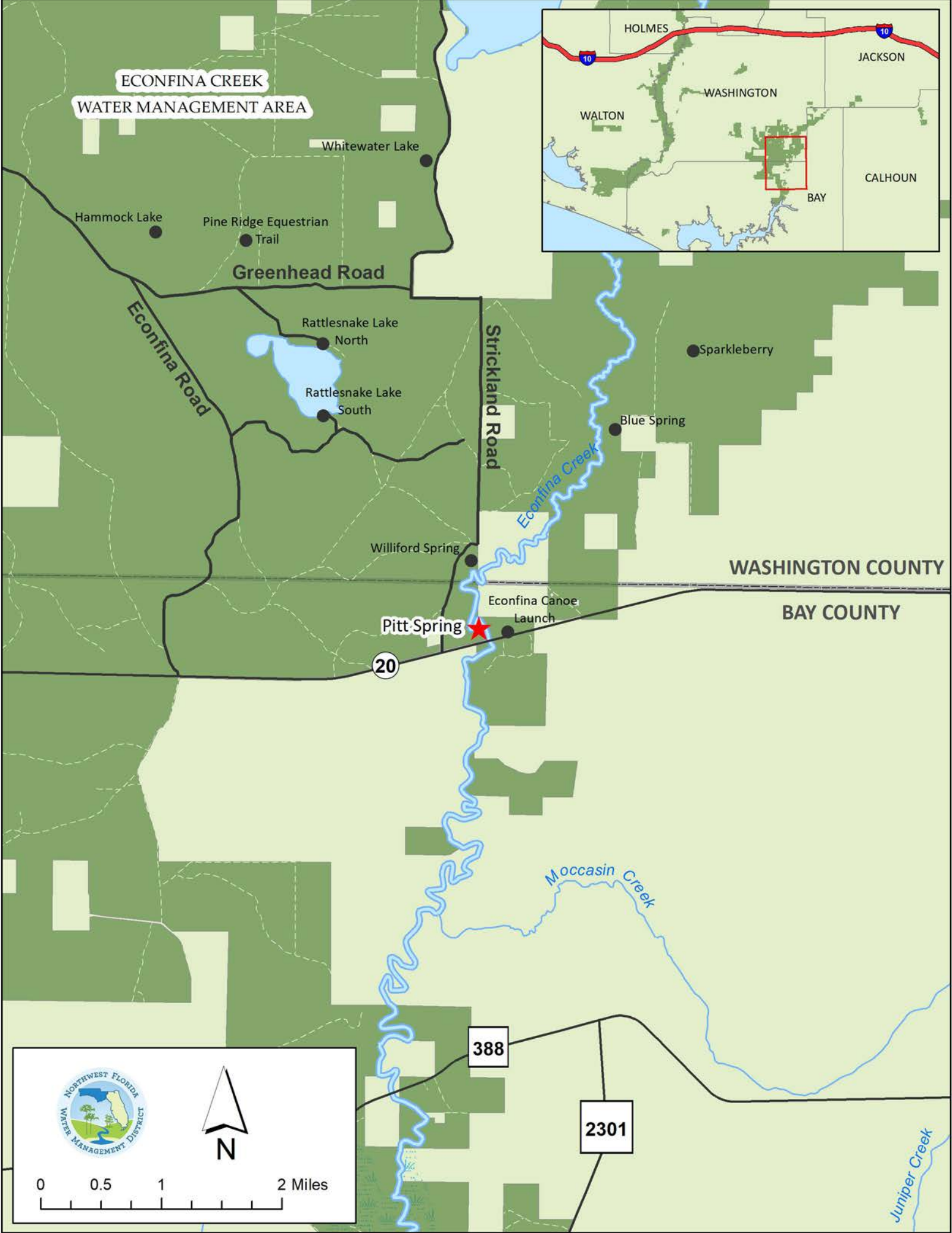
**Parking** is located inside Pitt Spring or an overflow parking area is located on Strickland Road. Parking on the side of the road is prohibited by law enforcement.
