Families can enjoy swimming, camping, kayaking, canoeing and fishing. This campsite can hold a maximum of 25 people. This is a gated area that requires an access code for entry into the area and is included in your permit. The nearest public boat ramp is located at Rattlesnake Lake North. 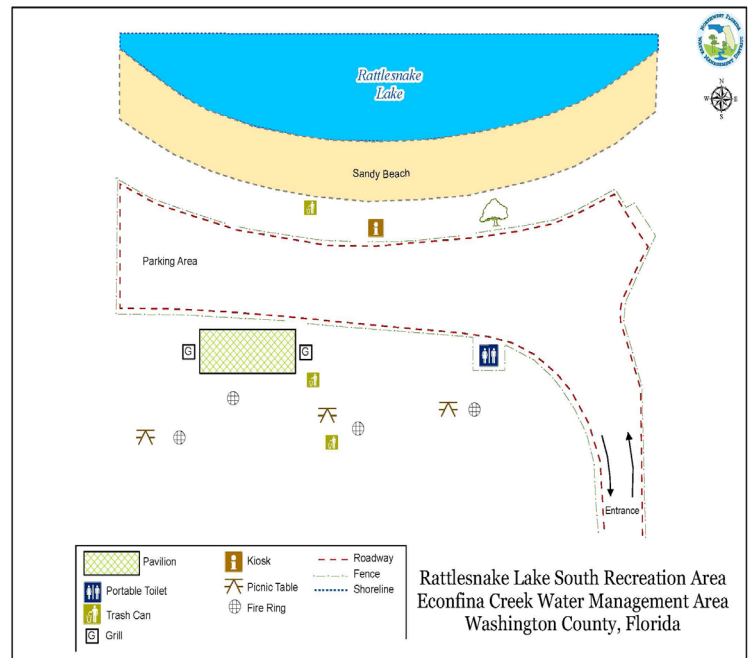

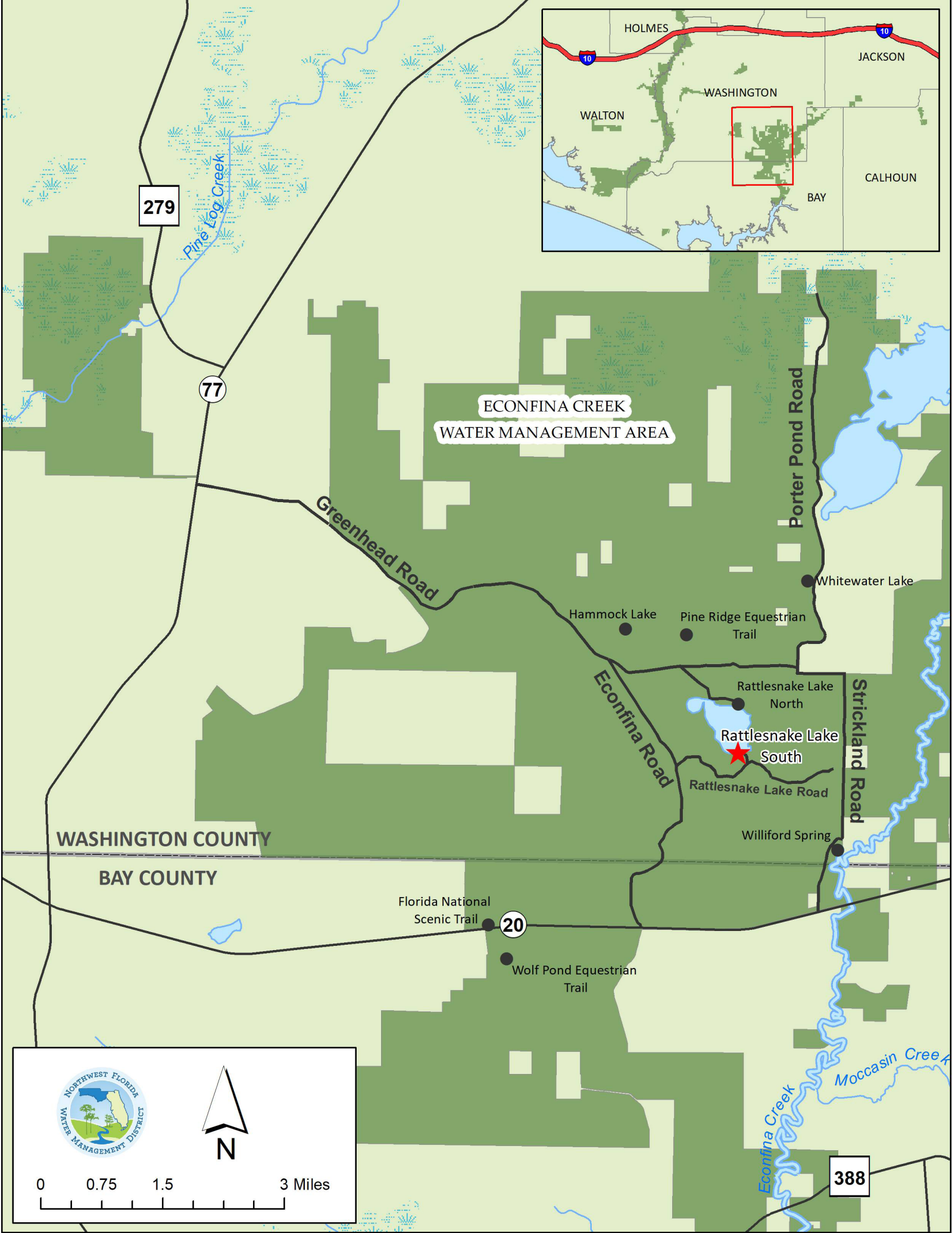

Bottom right: Rattlesnake Lake South campsite diagram






