Reference is made to your electronic mail dated March 3, 2014, in which you identified a clerical error in Special Condition number 6 of Nationwide Verification SAJ-2013-00985. Specifically, Special Condition number 6 referenced mitigation which will be completed as part of Department of the Army Permit (DA) number SAJ-2013-01012(IP-AWP) not SAJ-2019-00985(NW-AWP). DA permit SAJ-2013-01012 is the adjoining segment of roadway to this project. Per your point of clarification Special Condition number 6 has been corrected to reference the compensatory mitigation needed to fully offset the wetland functional loss associated with SAJ-2013-00985, State Road (SR) 123 from State Road (SR) 85 South to north of Tom's Creek Bridge, in Sections 4, 9, and 14, Township 01 South, Range 23 West, Niceville, Okaloosa County, Florida.

The corrected special condition now reads:

6. **Mitigation Credit Deduction:** Within 30 days from the date of initiating the authorized work the Permittee shall provide verification to the Corps that 0.14 palustrine forested federal mitigation credits have been deducted from the Corps/NWFWMD Umbrella Plan. The required verification shall reference this project's permit number (SAJ-2013-00985).

CREDIT RESERVATION, PURCHASE AGREEMENT AND CERTIFICATE

The Northwest Florida Water Management District (NWFWMD), a Florida governmental agency and sponsor of the NWFWMD In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Program, (hereinafter referred to as "Seller"), does hereby reserve and set aside for future assignment for the sole benefit of the Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as "Buyer"), a total of <u>0.14 federal/state Palustrine Forested</u> <u>Wetland Mitigation UMAM Credits</u> from the Lafayette Creek In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Area credit ledger, issued to Seller's In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Program pursuant to United States Army Corps of Engineers Permit Number SAJ-2011-00287-TMF and provisions contained in 33 CFR, Parts 325 and 332, as revised effective June 9, 2008 (Federal Mitigation Rule).

This reservation is for use of credit in connection with mitigating adverse wetland impacts which may arise as a result of construction or other projects undertaken or to be undertaken by the Buyer for FDOT Financial Project ID (FPID) 411102-2—SR 123 from North of SR 85 to North of Tom's Creek in Okaloosa County (USACE Permit #SAJ-2013-00985 NW-AWP; FDEP Permit #46-0314567-003-SI). Seller warrants that it will take no action inconsistent with the reservation and future assignment described herein. However, this agreement does not constitute a permit or permission to proceed with any proposed action. The Buyer is responsible for obtaining all necessary permits for a proposed action.

Seller received full Purchase Price from Buyer in June 2013. Seller is committed to transfer to Buyer 0.14 federal/state mitigation credits from the Lafayette Creek In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Area federal and state credit ledgers for use in offsetting wetland impacts. The Purchase Price for 0.14 federal/state Wetland Mitigation Credits is <u>seventy-three thousand seventy-one dollars and no cents (\$73,071.00</u>). Seller will assume full legal responsibility for success of purchased mitigation credits as required by permits noted above, and will at the appropriate time request withdrawal of the specified credits from the federal Lafayette Creek In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Area credit ledger, and will withdraw the specified credits from the state Lafayette Creek Umbrella Plan credit ledger.
