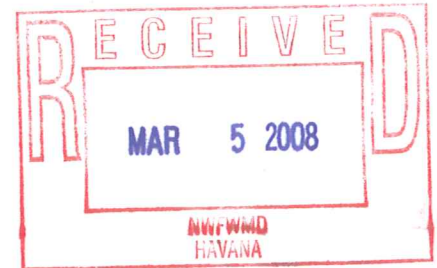

Sand Hill Lakes Mitigation Bank

Your request to modify this permit has been received, reviewed and approved by Department staff. The modification is to withdraw a total of 6.97 herbaceous credits, 34.42 flatwoods credits and 35.54 mixed hardwood credits from the above referenced mitigation bank as mitigation for the following Department of Environmental Protection permits issued to the Department of Transportation, District 3:

03-0268000-001, issued 3/16/07	(16.1 flatwoods, 2.25 mixed hardwoods)
03-0198380-001, issued 9/23/02	(1.68 herbaceous, 4.33 flatwoods, 8.08 mixed hardwoods)
03-0202923-002, issued 12/20/02	(1.33 herbaceous, 3.42 flatwoods, 6.38 mixed hardwoods)
03-0195655-001, issued 8/2/02	(3.44 herbaceous, 9.19 flatwoods, 16.37 mixed hardwoods)
03-0192214-002, issued 4/26/02	(0.52 herbaceous, 1.38 flatwoods, 2.46 mixed hardwoods)

These permits were issued in association with Ch 373.4137, F.S. and the Regional Mitigation Plan developed by the Northwest Florida Water Management District pursuant to OGC #99-1877, which references the Sand Hill Lakes region acquisition area. Specific credits numbers and types are not provided in these permits, but were determined based upon the impact acreage and function, and in association with the corresponding US Corps of Engineers permits.

In accordance with Specific Condition 20 of your permit, the ledger is hereby debited per your request.

By copy of this letter and accompanying ledger, we are notifying all necessary parties of the modification.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's action may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permittee and the parties listed below must be filed within 21 days of receipt of this letter. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the permittee at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Section 120.57, F.S.

The Petition shall contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the permittee's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action; or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any;
- (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this letter. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any decision of the Department with regard to the permit have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. The petition must conform to the requirements specified above and be filed (received) within 21 days of receipt of this notice in the Office of General Counsel at the above address of the Department. Failure to petition

within the allowed time frame constitutes a waiver of any right such person has to request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S., and to participate as a party to this proceeding. Any subsequent intervention will only be at the approval of the presiding officer upon motion filed pursuant to Rule 28-5.207, F.A.C.

This Notice constitutes final agency action unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for an extension of time this Notice will not be effective until further Order of the Department.

Any party to this letter has the right to seek judicial review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000; and by filing a copy with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date the Notice of Permit Modification is filed with the Clerk of the Department.
