The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request dated July 30, 2008 in which you asked to revise the project impact authorized by Department of the Army permit number SAJ-2005-1406, for the discharge of fill material over approximately 2.78 acres of forested wetlands for road improvements to Interstate 10 and its intersection with State Road 263, dated April 7, 2006. The project is located west of the Interstate 10 and State Road 236 interchange, and ends west of Old Bainbridge Road, in Sections 16, 17, 18 & 19, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, and Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, in the City of Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida.


The proposed modification is to correct the acreage impact amount from 2.78 acres to 1.9 acres. The requested modification does not increase the size of the project nor does it request a modification the approved work. No new project plans or Special Conditions have been attached to this letter.

The impact of your proposal on navigation and the environment have been reviewed and found to be insignificant. The permit is hereby modified in accordance with your request. You should attach this letter to the permit. All conditions of the permit remain in full force and effect.
