Dear Ms. Giddens:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request received December 7, 2009. The project known as the replacement of the U.S. 98 Wakulla River Bridge is located over the Wakulla River at US 98, in Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, Wakulla County, Florida.

The proposed modification is to change the mitigation condition #4 of the permit which required acquisition of 13 acres at the Ferrell Tract. The mitigation will be shifted from the Ferrell Tract to the Shuler Property and will be accomplished by debiting 4.92 forested UMAM credits from the Shuler Property. Also requested is the installation of a temporary work platform on the north side of the proposed bridge. The temporary work platform will be removed when the permanent bridge is constructed. The middle channel of the river will remain open for boat traffic and will be delineated with buoys.

The impact of your proposal on navigation and the environment have been reviewed and found to be insignificant. The permit is hereby modified in accordance with your request. You should attach this letter to the permit. All other conditions of the permit remain in full force and effect.
