SUBJECT:	Consideration of Resolution No. 812 Amending the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget - Amendment No. 2 - Realignment of Budget

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Governing Board adopt Resolution No. 812 amending the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget and allow staff to realign revenues and reserves to maintain the proper balance in each fund.

Background

Amendment No. 2 to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-2016 Budget realigns budget within and across programs, funds, projects, and categories. This amendment does not increase or decrease the total District budget.

A review of the District's latest expenditures indicates this action is required to properly reflect budgetary needs with associated year-to-date costs. Budget realignments include:

- \$62,278 in personnel budget transfers across programs and projects to accurately reflect where staff time and payments are being charged.
- \$20,000 in contractual service transfers that include \$15,000 from internal audit to Governing Board legal budget and \$5,000 from pre-land acquisition to special review and services for the Devil's Hole spring and Cotton Landing streambank restoration projects.
- \$112,798 in transfers from the operating expense category within the Information Technology (IT) Bureau to provide:
 - \$57,798 in capital outlay for servers originally budgeted incorrectly as operating expenses;

- \$25,000 in contractual services to update to the Office 365 Email Exchange; and
- \$30,000 in contractual services for infrastructure assessment and remediation plans of the District's network, servers, and other hardware.
- \$12,900 in a revenue transfer back to fund balance, due to a donation from the Nature Conservancy for reforestation in the Econfina Creek Water Management Area.

RESOLUTION NO. 812

NORTHWEST FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 BUDGET

WHEREAS, chapters 200 and 373, Florida Statutes, require the Governing Board of the Northwest Florida Water Management District (District) to adopt a final budget for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 120.525, Florida Statutes, the District has provided notice of its intention to amend the Budget in the published notification of the Governing Board meeting at which the amendment will be considered; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Northwest Florida Water Management District, that:

The Budget is hereby amended as summarized in the memorandum dated April 27, 2016, requesting Amendment No. 2 to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 budget. Amendment No. 2 reallocates budget authority across programs, funds, projects, and budget categories to properly reflect activities performed and accurately assign actual costs with no increase to the total District budget.
