RE: Amended Annual Regulatory Plan

To Whom It May Concern:

As required by section 120.74, F.S., the Northwest Florida Water Management District (District) has reviewed its rules to ensure compliance with statutory requirements. The following laws were enacted or amended during the previous twelve (12) months which create or modify the duties or authority of the agency. The following laws do not require the agency to adopt new or amend current administrative rules for proper implementation. Each of the laws identified below is being implemented by complying with the statutory requirements therein.

- 2023-020: Florida Shared-Use Nonmotorized Trail Network
- 2023-032: Prohibited Applications of Government-Issued Devices
- 2023-041: Statutorily Required Reports
- 2023-074: OGSR/Water Management District Surplus Lands
- 2023-154: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services
- 2023-169: Environmental Protection
- 2023-173: Economic Programs
- 2023-193: Retirement
- 2023-231: Flooding and Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Studies
- 2023-239: General Appropriations Act
- 2023-304: Natural Emergencies

On August 14, 2023, The District submitted its Annual Regulatory Plan (ARP) to the Office of Fiscal Accountability and Regulatory Reform (OFARR), and to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC), and published same on its website, www.nwfwater.com. After doing so, additional laws (2023-020: Florida Shared-Use Nonmotorized Trail Network, 2023-154: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and 2023-173 Economic Programs) were identified that required inclusion in the ARP. Thus, the District is publishing this Amended ARP in accordance with section 120.74(7), Florida Statutes. The District will also publish notice in the Florida Administrative Registrar identifying the date of publication of the Amended ARP, along with a hyperlink to the plan. The District is also submitting its Amended ARP to OFARR and JAPC.


