Dear Water Well Contractor:

This letter is a reminder that your water well contractor license will expire on July 31, 2025. Your license renewal is either incomplete or has not been received by the District as of this date. As of August 1, 2025, you will no longer be authorized to obtain well permits from the District if your license is not renewed. Any work performed without an active license or active permit will be in violation of, and subject to, the enforcement action under Chapter 373, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 40A-3, Florida Administrative Code.

Should you fail to renew your water well contractor's license by July 31, 2025, your license will automatically revert to inactive status. After July 31, in addition to the standard \$50 renewal fee, a late fee of \$75 will be required for license renewal. Any application for license renewal submitted after one year from the July 31, 2025 deadline will require you to reapply for the license and pass the Water Well Contractor Examination.

If you have any unresolved enforcement actions against your license, you may be required to resolve these actions prior to license renewal.
