Minimum Qualifications:

All positions required a competency with hydrologic and/or hydrogeologic principles related to surface and groundwater systems and a valid Drivers's License.

Level II – Bachelor's degree (B.S.) from an accredited college or university in hydrology, geology, civil/environmental engineering, or other water resources related field and five years of relevant experience; Master's degree and two years of relevant experience.

Level III – Bachelor's degree (B.S.) from an accredited college or university in hydrology, geology, civil/environmental engineering, limnology, ecology, or other water resources related field and five years of relevant experience; Master's (M.S.) degree and four years experience, or; or a doctoral (Ph.D.) degree and two years of relevant experience.

Special Abilities:

Knowledge and experience regarding the construction, calibration, and implementation of groundwater flow and/or surface water models. Knowledge of advanced statistics used to assess and manage water resources including aquifers, springs, rivers, lakes, estuaries, and rainfall. Excellent written and verbal communication skills and the ability to effectively communicate technical information.

Description of Position:

This is a full-time position (40 hours per week) entailing technical work in the areas of hydrology, hydrogeology, hydrologic modeling, statistical analysis and water resources management.

- Prepares and presents technical reports on surface water and/or groundwater resources of the District including hydrologic, hydraulic and water quality analyses.
- Assists in river basin analysis including flooding, low flows, water budgets, rainfall/runoff and calibration of hydrologic watershed models.
- Working knowledge and experience with the development and calibration of surface water (hydraulic and hydrologic) and/or numerical groundwater flow and transport models
- Performs statistical analysis of water quality, rainfall, water level and discharge data.
- Prepares and manages proposals, scopes of work, budgets, schedules, and tasks orders and oversees contractors.
- Plans and participates in field studies, such as hydrologic data collection, well construction, and water quality sampling.
- Other work tasks as directed by the supervising professional.
